


Greenmoss website

SURGERY STATISTICS

During the month of January a total of 3,437 appointments were booked

[Note that 'booked' appointments does not equate to 'available' appointments and does not <u>take into account</u> whether the patient attended or not.]

On average 173 appointments per 1000 patients were booked per week.

[Note that this is ALL appointments with ALL HCPs.]

DNAs

1 in 63 appointments were missed, resulting in 14 hours of wasted practitioner time.
